

BACHELOR OF APPLIED SCIENCE TEACHER EDUCATION APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Congratulations on your interest in pursuing a Bachelor of Applied Science in Teacher Education (BASTE) degree!

Columbia Basin College (CBC) is accredited as a BAS degree-granting institution by the Northwest Commission on

Colleges and Universities, an institutional accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation
and the U.S. Department of Education. Upon successful completion of the program, students become eligible for a
teacher certification in the state of Washington (Endorsement: Early Childhood Education).

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All students must be enrolled full-time during the 2-year cohort program including the student teacher residency in the second year.
- All admitted students are required to complete a criminal background check which includes fingerprinting and screening administered through the Office for the Superintendent of Public Instruction. Additional information will be provided upon admission.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must have met the following requirements:

- Earned at least an associate degree in early childhood education, closely related field, or completed at least 90 college-level credits from an academic transfer or career/technical program.
- Taken WEST-B Placement Test (or have scheduled WEST-B test, please provide date).
- Completed Early Childhood Education prerequisites with a minimum course grade of 2.7 and a minimum course grade of 2.0 in General Education prerequisites (see page 4 for full prerequisite course list).

If you have questions about your prerequisites, we strongly encourage you to consult the program advisor. (completion coach – contact information is provided in the following pages) There may be equivalent courses which can meet your eligibility requirements which the program advisor (completion coach) will have knowledge of.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

- Full-time enrollment for fall quarter opens on January 1 and applications will continue to be accepted until the cohort is full.
- Each program reviews completed applications and admits new students during the academic year. While new applications are continuously reviewed, new BAS-TE students start in the fall of the next year. Applicants are strongly encouraged to submit their applications early; seats in these classes are limited. In order for your application to be considered, all steps must be completed with the required materials submitted.
