

## Wireless Network Configuration for Windows 7

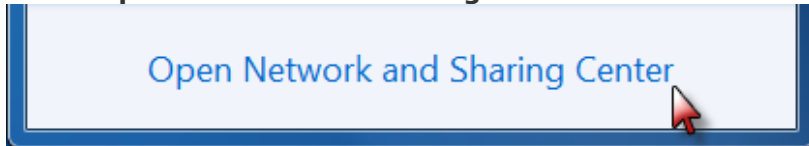
**NOTE:** Read the numbered steps. Failure to read the steps may cause errors that require users to start over.

### Procedure:

1. Click the **network connections icon**



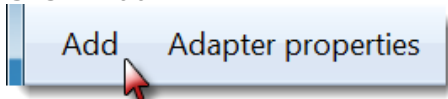
2. Click "Open Network and Sharing Center"



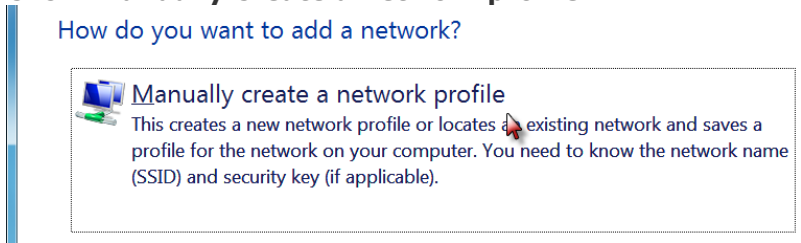
3. Click "Manage wireless networks"



4. Click "Add"



5. Click "Manually Create a network profile"



6. **Type "students"** (all lowercase without quotes) in the "Network name:" field
7. **Select "WPA2-Enterprise"** from the "Security type:" drop-down box
8. **Click Next**

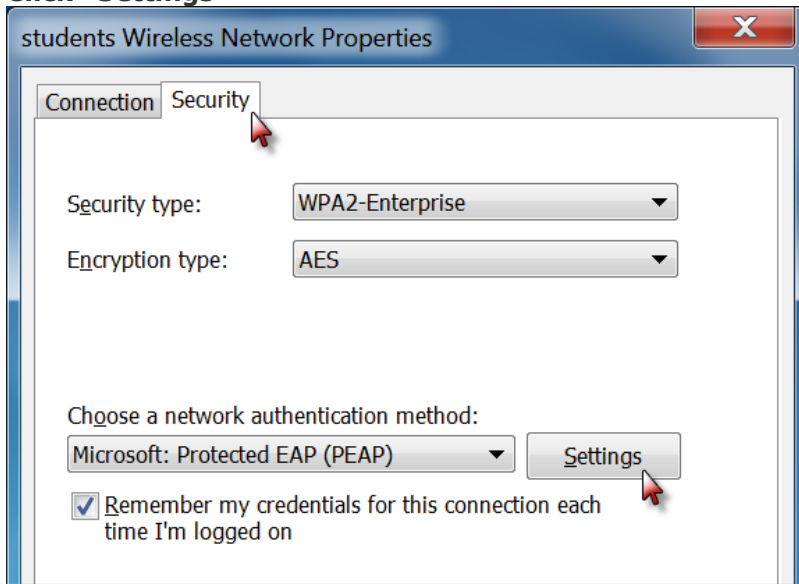

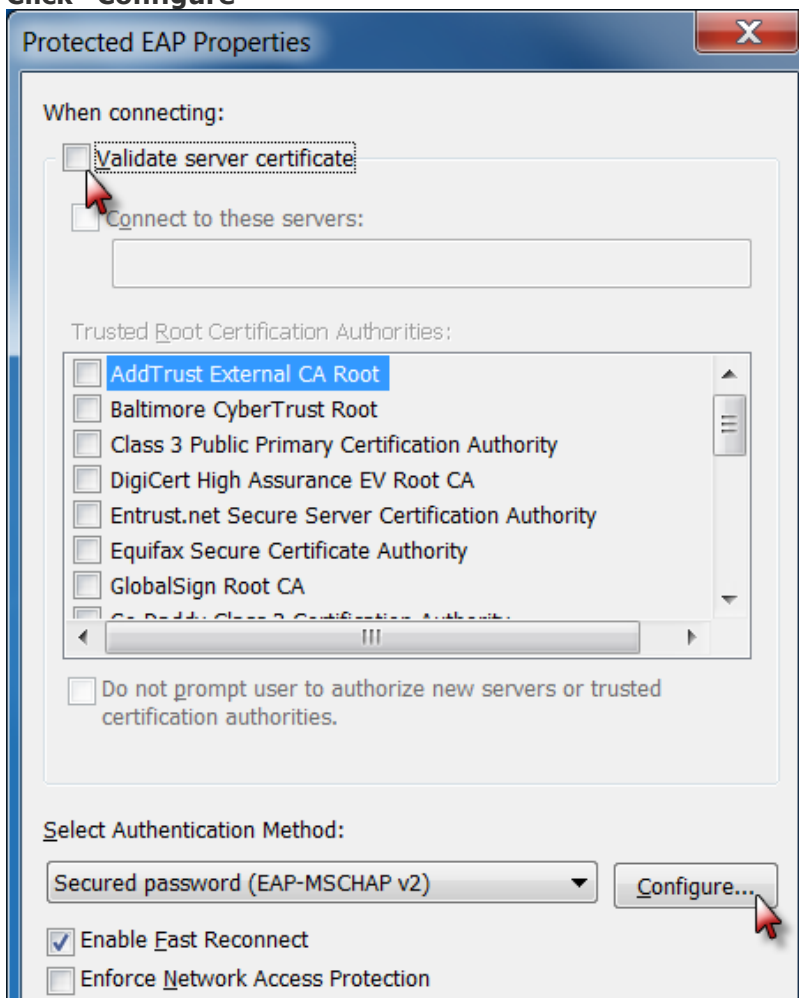

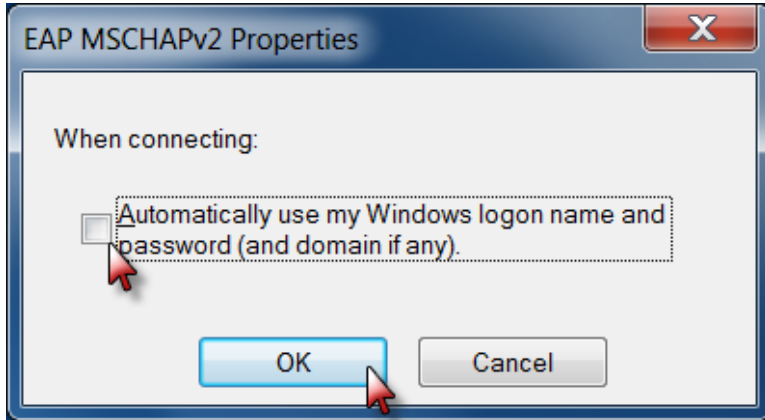
- 10. Click "Security"
- 11. Click "Settings"



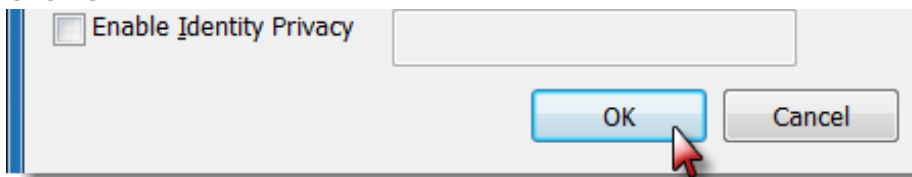
- 12. Un-check "Validate server certificates"
- 13. Click "Configure"



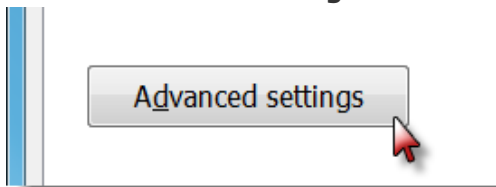
- 14. Un-check "Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)."
- 15. Click OK



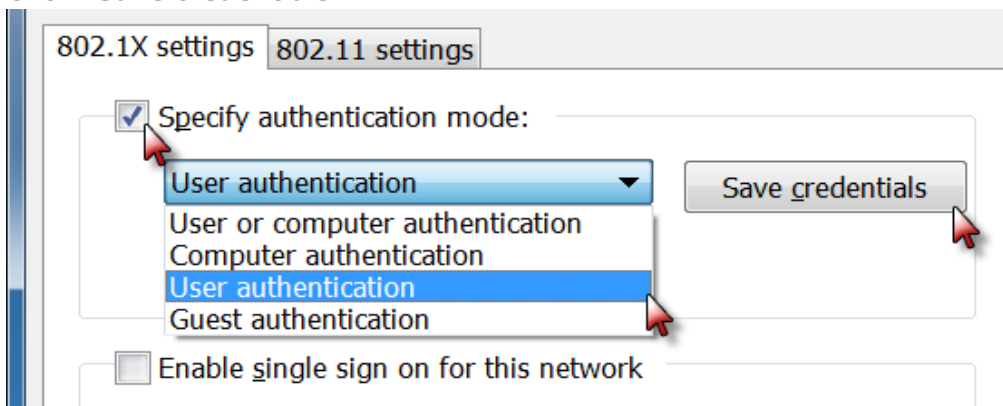

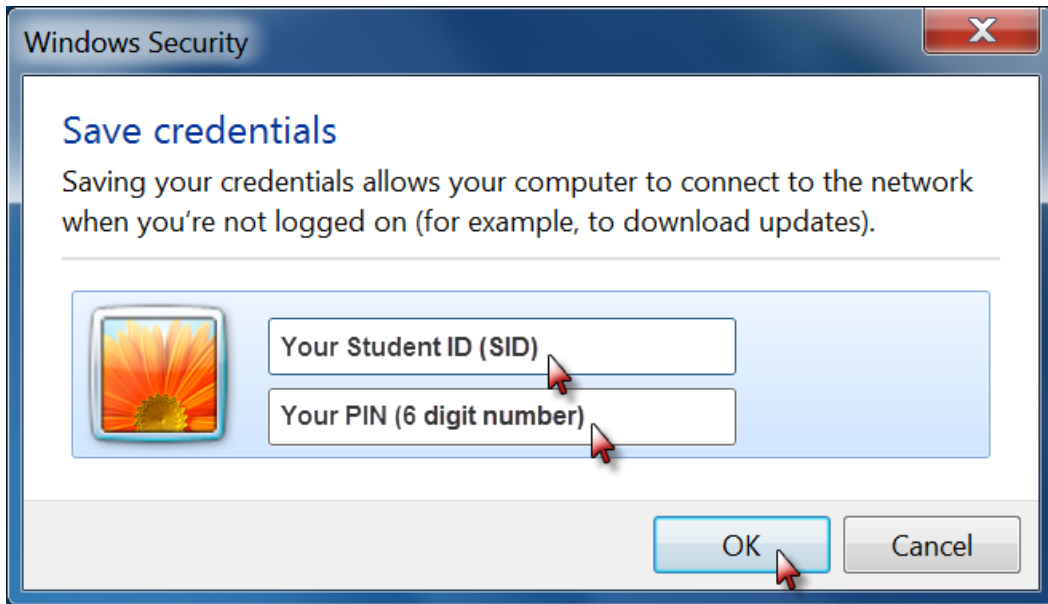
- 17. Click "Advanced settings"



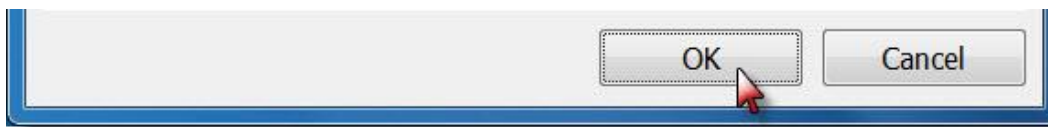
- 18. Check "Specify authentication mode:"

- 20. Click "Save credentials"



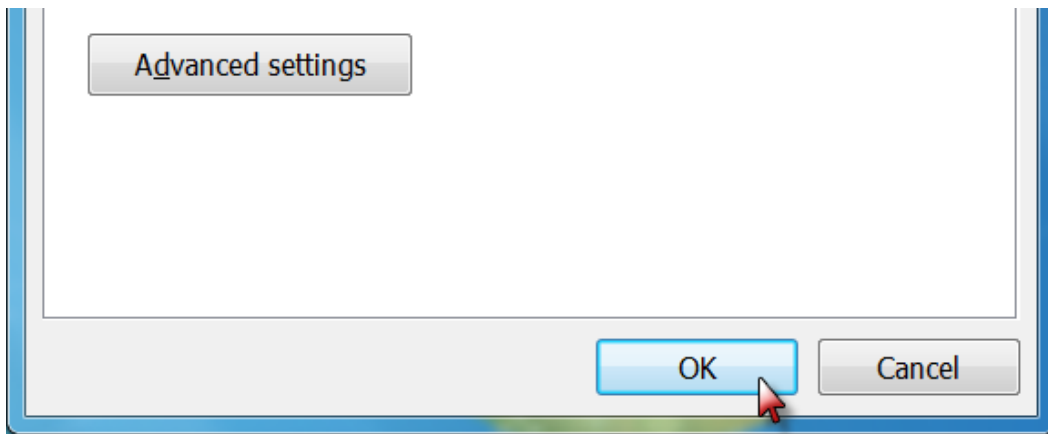
- 21. **Type User Name** (Student ID)

- 23. **Click OK**



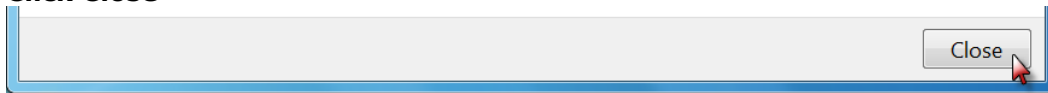
- 24. **Click OK**
