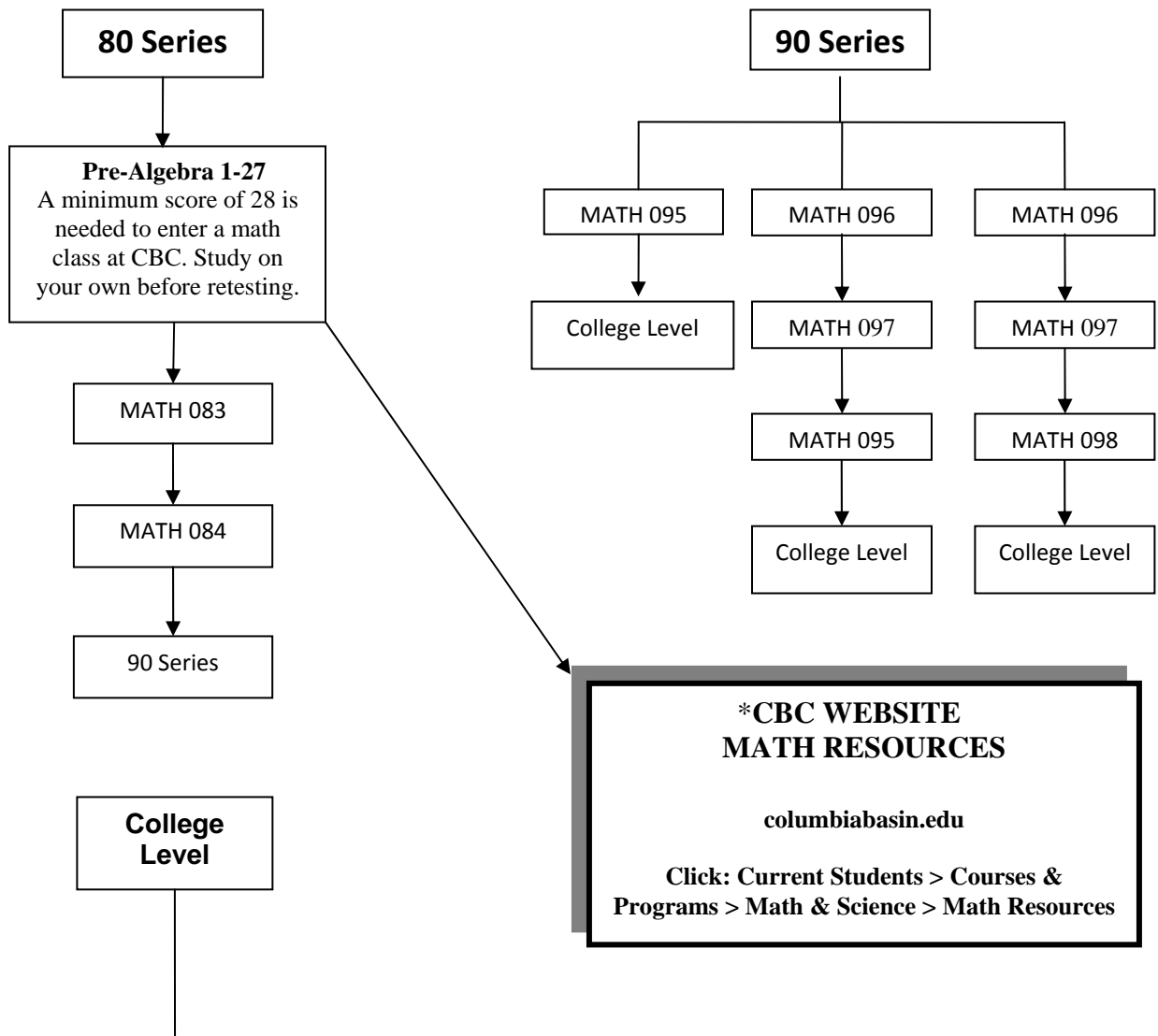

These classes satisfy the requirements for specific technical/vocational programs but are generally not transferable:
