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GENERAL INFORMATION

House Capacity

- Full 3/4 Thrust Theatre, stadium seating in four sections. (Seating Chart available upon request)
- Seating Capacity: 284 plus wheelchair accessible area

Loading Facilities

A roll up loading bay door is located off stage left through the scene shop. It is the same grade as the stage and is 8'-0" wide by 14'-0" high.

Crew Information

The number of crew provided by the event is determined by the Theatre Coordinator, unless specified by the Requesting Group. The crew's wages are hourly (currently \$7.35 to \$15.00 per hour) and are an additional cost to the Theatre Rental Fees (\$125/day). The house staff consists of trained students supervised by the Theatre Coordinator. All stagehands are non-union.

- Proscenium Arch - 31'-7"w by 16'-0"h
- Proscenium Arch to Downstage edge – 20'-7"
- Proscenium Arch to Upstage wall – 18'-0"
- Backstage Right Dimensions – 8'-0" by 12'-0"
- Backstage Left Dimensions – 12'-0" by 24'-0"

Flooring

- Stage Floor: plywood painted flat black
- Back stage: cement
- No dance floor available

Communications

- "Clear Com Style" Headsets are available with advanced notice/permission. This includes 3 in the booth (sound op, light op, and stage manager) and 2 headsets that can be ran to needed position (i.e. follow spots, backstage)
- Telephone available for off-campus calls located Back stage left near dressing rooms. No direct-dialed long distance calls can be made; only credit card calls. A pay phone is located in the lobby.
- Infrared Hearing Impaired System, 8 Headsets.

Dressing Rooms (Available with advance notice / approval subject to availability)

Two dressing rooms are located backstage left with mirrors, costumes racks, and toilets. The women's can hold 14 people comfortably and the men's only 8.

Wardrobe Facilities

One iron and ironing board is available with prior notice.

There is a washing machine & dryer **available only with advance notice/approval.**

HOUSE MANAGEMENT

Due to fire and safety codes, audience size is strictly monitored. Every audience member must be in a seat and not exceed the house capacity of 284 seats. There is wheelchair seating via an elevator behind the last row.

There is no 'Standing Room' permitted in the facility. The Requesting Group has options on how to manage the house:

1. **Provide your own House Manager for the event.** The Requesting Group must provide a House Manager to monitor the door and the size of the audience. The House Manager will close the doors when a full house is reached and deal with the public at the door. If the audience grows beyond the capacity, the Requesting Group and their House Manager is responsible to reduce the audience to the proper number (284) before the event will be allowed to begin.
2. **CBC will provide a House Manager for you.** The Theatre Coordinator will provide a House Manager and/or ushers to monitor the door. This person has the final say of the size of the audience and will act as the public liaison as described above. The requesting group will be responsible for the wages of the employee(s).

AUDIO SYSTEM

House System

The House System is primarily used for theatrical performances, spoken word events and lectures. It is not designed for musical concert/events. Console is located in the control booth that has windows that can be opened.

There are monitors of the stage in the dressing rooms, green room, control booth, and backstage right and left.

LIGHTING SYSTEM

House System

A basic stage wash is hung for the event and a Lighting Plot (hard copy or Softplot file) is available upon request. The system can dim this wash and has full control of the audience lighting via a computer lighting console. This console is capable of recording "lighting cues" as needed for the event.

Adjustment to the lighting requires advance notice and approval at an additional hourly labor charge.

Lighting Control

The Light Board is an ETC 24/48 Express with 96 channels and 24 submasters. It is connected to a Colortran Dimmer rack housing 160 2.4K dimmers. The patch is 1 to 1.

RIGGING SYSTEM

Fly System (Fly Schedule available upon request)

- The linesets are half-fly and are able to fly out approximately 6'-0".
- Movie screen is available for most events and fills the Proscenium Arch.
- Wire-guide single purchase counterweight system for electrics, movie screen, and traveler only. The rest are hemp line systems with some clew blocks and sandbags available.
- All linesets are 40'-0" long
- Fly rail is located backstage right.
- **No shifting or flying scenery without advanced notice/approval.**
May require extra paid crew.
