<p>Reports MRTE Analysis of Completions</p>	<p><u>Joe Montgomery</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At the February, 2013, Board meeting initial analyses of the MRTE+ dataset was presented, showing transfer rates of CBC students who had earned their AA degrees. Several questions were raised during this presentation, such as the extent to which the transfer rates indicated good or bad performance by CBC and an interest in the broader issue of transfer by all CBC students, not just those earning an AA degree. The analyses provided in the current report attempt to respond to these questions. • Based on the follow-up analyses, CBC's performance was consistently quite positive compared to other community colleges in the state. Overall, the odds of transferring are fairly high for students who earn an AA degree. Placing at the college level in Math makes transfer considerably more likely than pre-college placement, but the odds are not as good as for obtaining the AA degree. • Additional follow-up analyses remain, including examining transfer rates by ethnic group and other demographic factors, and moving on to analysis of baccalaureate graduation rates. • Chair Mitchell thanked Joe for the detailed report.
