- ☐ **Complete your Master Promissory Note (1st time borrowers*)**: You will complete your MPN at <https://studentaid.gov>. Make sure you have viewed it in both the PDF version and the HTML version. Print a copy of the PDF version for your records.
- * If you have borrowed a prior Federal Direct Loan you can skip steps 1 and 2 because you have already completed the MPN and Entrance Counseling. If you are unsure if you have met these requirements, email us at financialaid@columbiabasin.edu.*
