Congratulations on your interest in pursuing a Bachelor of Applied Science in Teacher Education (BASTE) degree!

Columbia Basin College (CBC) is accredited as a BAS degree-granting institution by the Northwest Commission on

and the U.S. Department of Education. Upon successful completion of the program, students become eligible for a
teacher certification in the state of Washington (Endorsement: Early Childhood Education).

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Students may enroll as a full- or part-time student while completing coursework.
- All students must enroll as a full-time student during the residency year (last 3 quarters in the program).
- All admitted students are required to complete a criminal background check which includes fingerprint screening
  administered through the Office for the Superintendent of Public Instruction. Additional information will be
  provided upon admission.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Applicants must have met the following requirements:

- Earned at least an associated degree in the early childhood education or closely related field or completed at least 90 college-level credits from an academic transfer or career/technical program.
- Taken WEST-B Placement Test (or WEST-B alternative such as the SAT or ACT).
