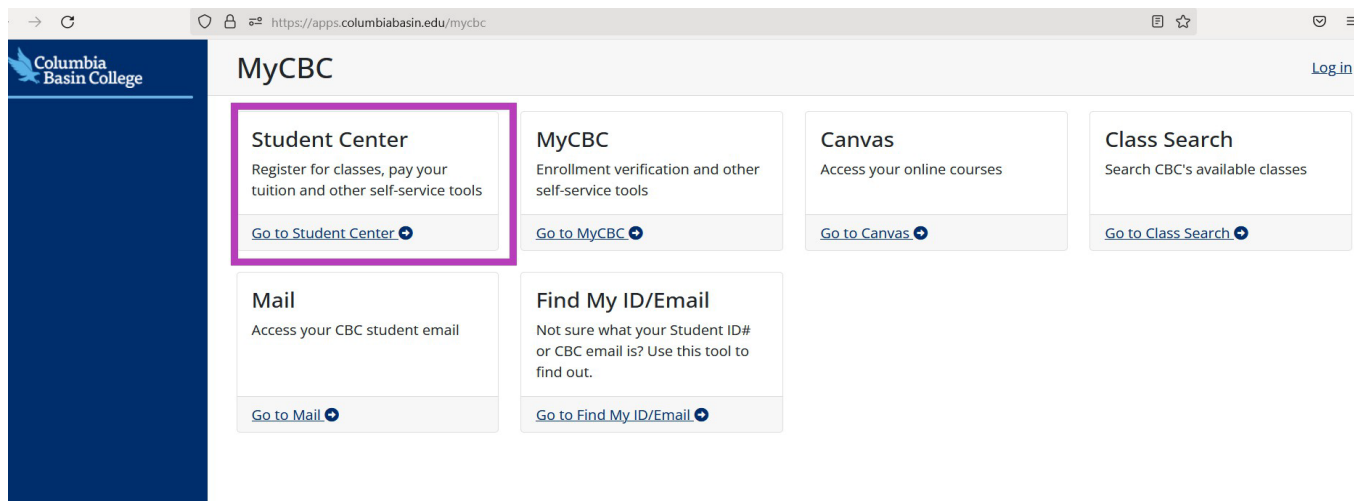


Viewing Your Academic Advisement Report in ctcLink

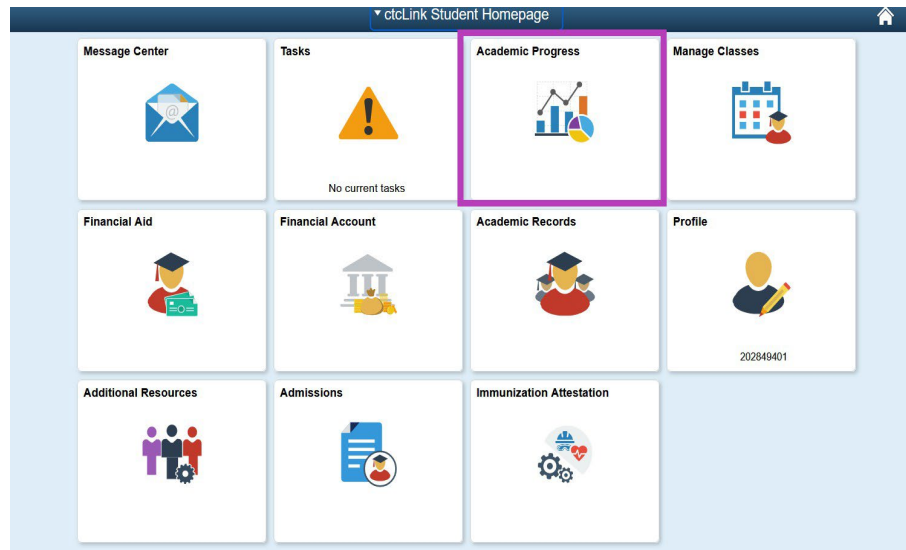
1. Go to MyCBC at: <https://apps.columbiabasin.edu/mycbc> and click on **Student Center**.
