- 3. Cum GPA of 2.3 or higher & a grade less than "C" (2.0) in Geometry
- **4.** Cum GPA of 2.3 or higher & a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher in Geometry **OR** Cum GPA of 2.3 or higher & any grade in Intermediate Algebra
- **5.** Cum GPA of 3.0 or higher & a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher in Intermediate Algebra **OR** Cum GPA of 2.3 or higher & a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher in Pre-calculus
- 6. Cum GPA of 3.0 or higher & a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher in Pre-calculus
- 7. Cum GPA of 3.0 or higher & a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher in Calculus AB and/or BC
