### 1.0 Smoke & Tobacco Free Objectives and Responsibilities

Pursuant to action by Administration, a resolution to implement a policy for smoke and tobacco-free buildings and vehicles of Columbia Basin College (CBC) has been adopted. In favor of a clean air environment in all college facilities:

- 1.1 Smoking and tobacco products are not allowed inside any building or vehicle operated by CBC.
- 1.2 Smoking materials and related tobacco supplies will not be available for sale or vended on the campuses.
- 1.3 Smoking and tobacco use is prohibited within at least fifty (50) feet of building openings (i.e., doors, air intakes, windows), and spaces near outdoor work areas.
- 1.4 Smoking is prohibited in any location where the airflow carries smoke directly into a facility work area.
- 1.5 Smokers are to dispose of smoking and tobacco refuse in ash cans or other containers specifically designed and placed for such disposal.
- 1.6 CBC shall ensure, through proper posting that outside smoking and tobacco use areas are at least fifty (50) feet from doorways and air intakes.

The success of this policy depends upon the thoughtfulness, consideration, and cooperation of smokers, tobacco users and nonsmokers. All college community members and visitors share in the responsibility for adhering to the policy in order that the campuses may remain healthy, attractive, and inviting places for all to visit.
