**Purpose:** On May 19, 2020, the Federal Register printed amendments to Title IX regulations [85 FR 30575]. The new regulations address the grievance process for formal complaints of sexual harassment and are scheduled to take effect on August 14, 2020. This requires emergency updates to the College's Student Conduct Code to be compliant with federal regulations.
